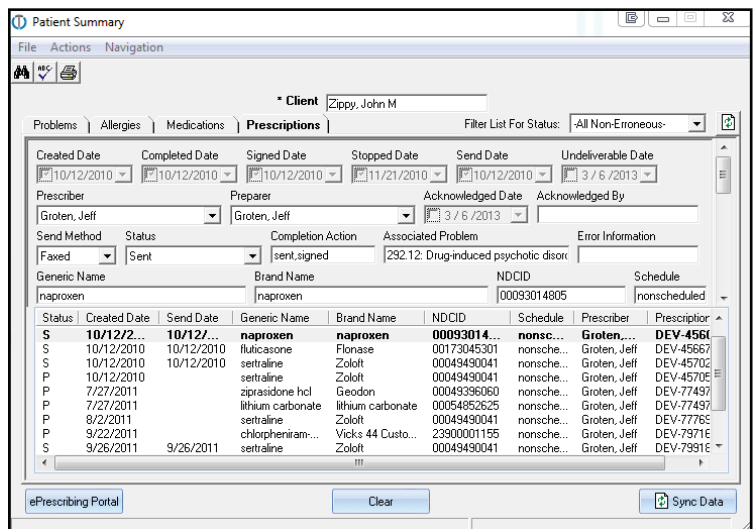

Electronic Prescriptions for Controlled Substances (EPCS)

Need a simple, secure, and affordable way to send controlled substance prescriptions electronically? EPCS Gold™ 2.0 through DrFirst is the first ever, fully certified solution that meets the prescription processing requirements set by Surescripts and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA). These are the rules enforced through the Interim Final Rule (IFR) and the Identity Proofing rules set by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST). In a two-year government-funded pilot under the auspices of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, EPCS Gold™ underwent rigorous testing and auditing to ensure the system's security and safety.

What prescriptions does EPCS allow?

- Schedule II – V drugs
- Other medications allowed according to individual state laws

Features:

- Provider authentication and registration

Provides DEA mandated Two-Factor Authentication Protocol (TFAP) for sending controlled substance prescriptions electronically.

- Administrative Console

The Administrative Console is a secure portal that allows you to register and manage EPCS access for prescribers as well as access reporting features and audit information.

- EPCS Signing Module

The Signing Module allows prescribers to sign and submit the Controlled Substance prescription electronically. The Signing Module has the following features:

- Displays DEA-mandated content
- Enforces two-factor authentication validation
- Transmits prescriptions in SCRIPT 8.1E format
- Logs all application activity for audit purposes
